<u>RULES & REGULATIONS:</u>		
<i>Gate Lock & Tool Bin Codes: 8400</i>		
Members are assigned to plots or barrels on a rotational basis, perHOA request form and distribution.		
Plot and barrel assignments will rotate based on the growing seasons noted above (i.e. If your barrel or plot was assigned to you during the Nov 3 growing season, your assignment will be up on April 30 and the plot will then be available to a different member).		
1. Member is responsible for their own plot - No vandalism of others' plots.		
2. Each member is responsible for hand watering and promotion of plant growth. No unattended watering will be allowed.		
3. Member is responsible for weeding, pest control, trimming, and promotion of plant growth.		
4. Tools belong to the Community Garden - members must return to the bin after use and the bin must be locked.		
5. Pest infestations must be monitored and must be taken care of timely by each member, no pest infestation to transfer to other plots.		
6. Fertilization of each member's plot and promotion of growth is the responsibility of the member.		
7. Control of vining plants is the responsibility of each member at their plot.		
8. Each member is responsible for pick up of litter at all times around their plots or any other litter seen while working in the garden.		
9. The combination of the lock is temporary and not allowed to be changed, and will not be given out to anybody other than the garden member. The Garden must be locked at all times when you vacate the garden area.		

10. Harvest all ripe fruit and vegetables on a daily basis, so as not to encourage bird and/or rodent activity in the garden.			
11. All that can be composted shall be in the bins provided in the garden and turned regularly.			
12. Smoking or chewing tobacco in the garden is prohibited - tobacco carries the mosaic virus which is deadly to some plants.			
13. No permanent structures are to be placed on a plot.			
14. Only organic, compostable material is to be placed in the composters provided, no trash please.			
15. Plants that are at the end of their productive life should be removed.			
16. All hoses to be stored back in bin and locked when done watering at each use - do not remove from the gated garden area.			
17. The tool bin and entry gate is to always be locked when you leave the garden.			
Each member is responsible for take down of their plot before the end of the growing season per the dates above or earlier.			
Hours of Operation: 7:00 AM to Sunset
